

2) Character of YCMGA. The activities of the YCMGA is supported by donations and various voluntary giving from organizations and individuals who have the goal of promoting horticulture, gardening education, and community improvement. As indicated in the Bylaws and by practice, no monies or benefits are inured to the benefit of any individual, or group of individuals, affiliated with the YCMGA.

As presented in the Bylaws, the objectives of the YCMGA are as follows:

- a.** To develop and sustain a viable and energetic group of educated volunteers to raise funds to support, enhance, and supplement Montana State University (MSU) Master Gardener programs in Yellowstone County;
- b.** To support, enhance and supplement the community educational efforts of the MSU Master Gardener Program and thereby provide education and information about horticulture, environmental stewardship, and community service to the residents of Yellowstone County;
- c.** To facilitate the exchange of information and ideas between and among associates and the community through all forms of media, public meetings, educational programs, and other activities;
- d.** To inform and educate the residents and decision-makers of Yellowstone County about the value of the MSU Master Gardener Program
